



Area F Guidelines: Geology/Geological Sciences

Area F consists of eighteen (18) hours of lower-division (1000- and 2000-level) courses related to the Geology program of study:

Geology	0 – 8 hours (if not taken in Area D)
Chemistry	0 – 8 hours (if not taken in Area D)
Calculus	0 – 4 hours (if not taken in Area A or D)

The remainder of the eighteen (18) hours should include courses from:

- Biology (for science/biology majors)
- Physics
- Chemistry
- Or other courses appropriate to the program and institution

Hours in excess of eighteen (18), and any prerequisite courses not already counted in the Core, must be counted in the general degree requirements for the major.
